

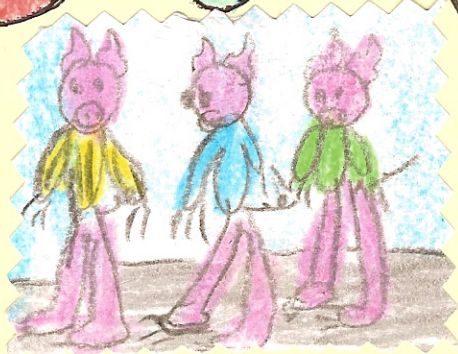

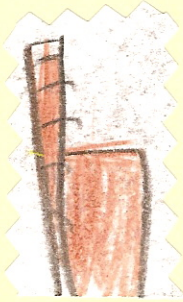


The wolf knocked on the door and said "little pig, little pig, let me come in".

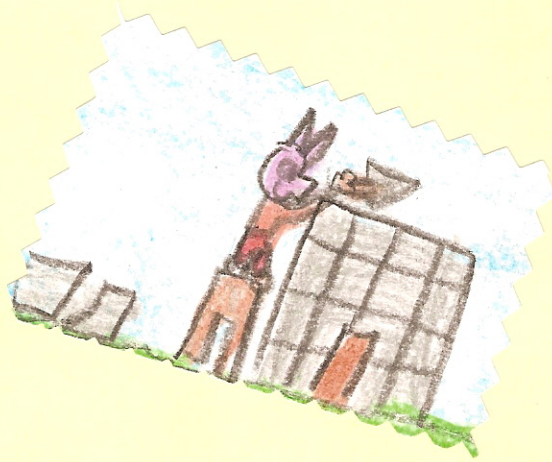

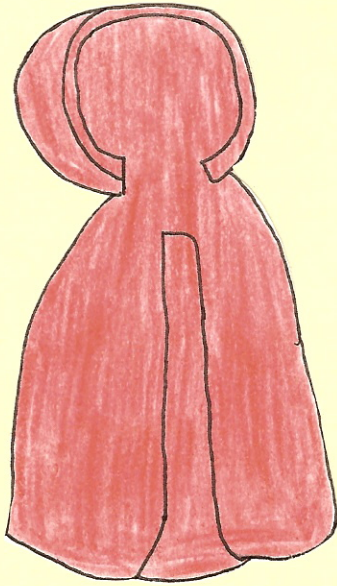

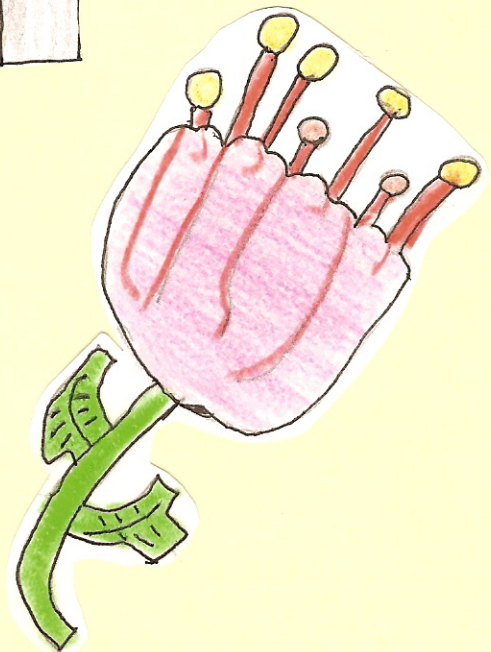
