

Living in a metropolis

Today we have identified important issues that metropolises all around the world deal with.

In two weeks we are going to meet in R. 111 again for the *H2 Metropolis Conference*. At this conference there will be a gallery walk with the results from your group work, afterwards you will give presentations to your classmates.

The tasks for your group work are as follows:

Monday, Feb. 6., 2012:

Agree in your group on two aspects that you find interesting for “your” metropolis (please refer to the aspects you have identified earlier).

Wednesday, Feb. 8., 2012:

Carry out research on your city so that you become experts of it.¹ You can use computers in the following rooms:

203, 06, 206, 216, 211

Monday, Feb. 13., 2012:

Prepare a written report *and* a poster for the gallery walk on February 15 and presentations in your classrooms.

You can use the following rooms: 203, 201, 206, 211

You can decide whether you prefer to work on an essay or to hold a presentation: Two students of your group are asked to write an essay dealing with one aspect each, while the other students should get ready for a 15-minute presentation of the metropolis and the two aspects.

Mind: All group members are responsible for the quality of all the elements of your group work. So, make sure that you double-check the quality. For the presentation: Keep in mind what you have learnt about aspects of a good presentation at the H2, so far.

Wednesday, Feb. 15, 2012:

Essays have to be handed in, the posters have to be ready for the gallery walk.

Please come to room 111 for the gallery walk. Afterwards there will be your presentations in your classrooms.

! In case you are ill, make sure your group has all the necessary material. On Feb. 15 you have to hand in an “Attest”, if you cannot show up. Send the essay by email to your course teacher by Feb. 15 at the latest!

Requirements:

1. What should be on the poster?

- Basic information on the metropolis (specifics, inhabitants, landmarks, sights...)
- Two aspects you have dealt with in a structured way (do not simply glue your essays on the poster)
- Pictures, charts,

2. How to write the essay?

- 1 page, line spacing: 1,5 pt, type size: 12 pt
- Do not simply paste and copy but use your own words as far as possible and pay attention to quoting correctly! State your sources!
