Realization phases (with teacher's role and reference files if necessary):	<p>With this approach we try to introduce the Romanesque style through the road to Santiago. When you enter you'll find:</p> <p>"El Románico" (The Romanesque)</p> <p>EContents : architecture, sculpture, painting and the most important monuments in Galicia and on the Road to Santiago. The e-contents are introduced through a website.</p> <p>"La catedral"(The cathedral)</p> <p>It's a video that shows the most characteristic elements of Romanesque style at the Cathedral of Santiago.</p> <p>"Visita Guiada" (Guided visit)</p> <p>It's explained with sounds (voice) all elements of "Portico de la Gloria" Romanesque facade of the cathedral in Santiago, we can find also written explanations.</p> <p>"Visita virtual" (virtual visit)</p> <p>Some of the most important monuments on the road to Santiago, the students find information about the monuments and Romanesque elements.</p> <p>"Actividades"(activities)</p> <p>We find three different types of activities</p> <p>Activity 1: Questionnaire made with PHP, it can be used at the beginning to make students think about the most important contents or at the end for self evaluation. It works also in the context of Music and Literature on the road to Santiago because this approach belongs to a wider proposal about the Road to Santiago.</p>

	<p>Activity 2: Made with Jclick tries to reinforce the econtent knowledge.</p> <p>Project: It's a collaborative approach in which students have to use the knowledge acquired through the learning process.</p> <p>These materials can be used by students on their own or in a classroom with the teacher as conductor.</p>
Considerations at the end of the experience:	The materials can be used in the classroom or at home. It has all the students need to learn the contents. e-contents, interactive exercises, and collaborative proposals. The collaborative work will let students develop different abilities like: to produce materials integrating the knowledge acquired in the learning process, design of websites.
