In the "Pórtico de la Gloria"Cathedral of Santiago there are 24 old men playing diferent instruments, with simulations we present the musical instruments, it also includes sound. Within three scores of Alfonso X El Sabio (a famous composer in those ages in Spain), the student can hear the music and do different exercices with them. Through a webquest we propose the collaborative work
