

Linguistic Situations for English Tenses:

*Tell when your next class will start

My next class starts at ten to ten.

*Make an **arrangement** for next Monday

I'm sailing with my yacht in the afternoon

*Tell us about the **current duration** of your studying Bacharelato

I've been studying Bacharelato for almost two years right now.

*Tell your mate about the duration of being sitting with him/her **up-to-date.**

I have sat with you for a year

*Tell us about three **simultaneous** actions you did this morning

I was eating my breakfast when I drank my coffee and I read the newspaper

*Write about one of your **past habits** that you dislike now

I used to bite my nails

*Express what you did **before** coming to this classroom

Before coming to this classroom I had gone to the bathroom.

*Let us know about **a very recent action** you saw done.

Salvado has just bitten his pen.

*Express what **will be happening** when you arrive home today

My mother will be eating when I arrive home today.

*Say what **will have happened** when you arrive home today

My father will have made our lunch.

***Express the **beginning** of your current activity in class**

We started making sentences a couple of minutes ago

***Tell us a very immediate action to be done by you next**

I'm about to type a sentence on the laptop

***Express the **duration** of your current activity in class**

I have been reviewing for the exam for twenty minutes .

***Show us **your plan** for today's evening**

I'm going to study English in the library.

***Give your **opinion about the future** of Spanish economy**

I think that Spanish economy will improve soon.

*****Predict** something about **your future****

I think that I'll have a happy long life.

&*Ask you mate about his/her **arrangements for tomorrow.**

What are you doing tomorrow?

Otero is studying tomorrow.
